



## Repak PPWR Transition Fund FAQs

### What is the €5 million PPWR Transition Fund?

Repak's Transition Fund has been established to support members as they prepare for the upcoming Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR).

The Fund provides financial recognition to members who engage in readiness activities that help Repak and our members transition smoothly to comply with the new regulations.

### What is PPWR?

PPWR is the new EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation that introduces harmonised rules on packaging design, reporting and recycling across all Member States.

Replacing the Packaging Directive, it introduces updated producer responsibilities and reporting requirements for packaging placed on the market.

Coming into effect from 2026, it contains stricter requirements for how packaging is designed, labelled, reported and recycled.

### How does it affect Repak Members?

Repak Members will be required to comply with all aspects of upcoming legislation as set out in PPWR. Find out more information in our [PPWR summary booklet](#) or contact our Membership team for guidance.

### How much of the Fund is available to me?

Each Member will receive further information in early 2026 outlining:

- The readiness activities you will be invited to complete (including a short self-assessment and supply-chain review form), and
- The timeline for processing payments under the Transition Fund.

### **What readiness activities will I have to complete?**

As part of the qualifying criteria for the Fund, members will be asked to:

1. Complete a short digital self-assessment form on your business model and packaging activities.
2. Provide a supply-chain overview, listing packaging or product suppliers that contribute to your reported tonnes.
3. Estimate the tonnes associated with imported or back-door packaging, as relevant.

### **When should this be completed?**

The self-assessment and additional forms should be submitted by 31st May 2026 to qualify for the payment cycle.

### **How will Repak use this information?**

To help both Members and Repak prepare for PPWR, we need to gather specific information about your business operations and packaging supply chain.

This will:

- Identify where packaging obligations may shift under the new producer definition
- Help Repak understand potential tonnes movement within the system.
- Allow us to target training, support, and resources for members most impacted by these changes.

Repak will provide, from January 2026:

- A clear instruction document and step-by-step videos for completing self-assessment and supply-chain review forms.
- Detailed FAQs and completed examples
